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Instructions and rules for transporting soil and waste to SKÅAB: s facilities.

The purpose of the current rules for the reception and disposal of waste is to protect the environment by requiring knowledge and documentation of the composition and properties of the soil/waste.

The regulations require all waste to be characterized. This means that the person who gives rise to the waste (waste producer) should know the waste's properties and contents of different substances and their possible leaching. The origin of the waste must also be clarified and it must be stated which activity has been carried out at the place where the waste occurred. Responsibility for the characterization and its content is the waste producer.

- **Characterization for inert masses is done by filling in the recipient form**

SKÅAB: s form contains several fields and boxes. The meaning of the questions in the boxes and fields is to ensure that the masses meet the requirements for reception. However, in NFS 2004:10 there are exceptions for certain masses that can be received without sampling, certain material and what type of activity that have been carried out on site before excavation.

If there is suspicion of contamination at the excavation or reception control, this should be investigated immediately.

If there is no knowledge of the waste and its character, it is the responsibility of the waste supplier to obtain this. However, SKÅAB can assist with this.

The staff at each plant are always available if there are questions regarding receipt control, forms and how to fill in them.

In some cases, SKÅAB has sent forms with the drivers, it is crucial that these are filled in correctly.

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
